









Example Implementation: Business Course

- 1.Understand the business practices and the world applications.
- 2. Video lectures, interactive simulations, and real-life case studies.
- 3. Weekly virtual problem-solving sessions in small groups for engagement.
- 4.Quizzes, peer-reviewed projects, and a cumulative online exam.
- 5. Automated feedback for quizzes; faculty will give feedback for student projects.



Example Implementation: Language Course

- 1.Develop conversational proficiency in a new language.
- 2. Virtual language labs, video dialogues, and cultural immersion videos.
- 3. Weekly virtual conversational partnered sessions for comprehension practice.
- 4. Speaking assessments with automated speech recognition, writing assignments, and comprehension quizzes.
- 5.Immediate pronunciation feedback, rubric-based grading for assignments.

Keep Text Minimal

Keep Bullet Point Short

Use Visual Contrast

Slide Deck Template

- One sentence
- Min. 7 words
- Points makes sense

- Bullets points
- Follows the same rules as your other slides
- One concept on each slide

- Good visuals
- Summarize
- One big image is more powerful than 3 small ones

- Template is available
- Working on a new more simplistic version
- Helps to follow same guidelines
